Celts A collection of tribes with origins in central Europe

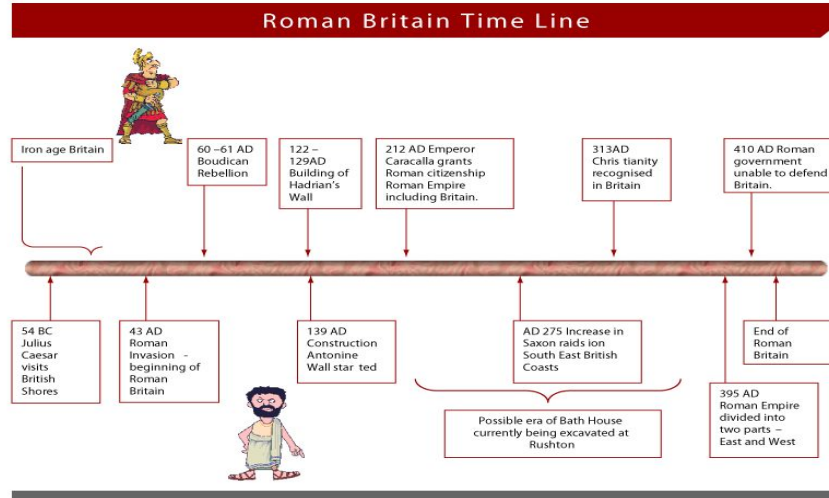
Hadrian's wall A Roman fortification built to protect the Roman province of Britannia
